EVENT FORMAT

The Horse & Hound Festival of Showjumping will run from Friday 13 to Sunday 15 July, with riders invited to arrive on Thursday 12 July from 3pm. Optional warm-up classes will commence on the Friday, at £15 entry per class. The championship will run across the Saturday and Sunday and is available to enter at £50 per combination, which includes entry to jump at your chosen height on both days. A fun top score class (£20 entry) and pairs class (£30 entry per pair) will take place on the Friday and Saturday evenings respectively.

THURSDAY 12 JULY

Riders are invited to arrive on Thursday 12 July from 3pm to settle their horses into stables and set up camp. Welcome drinks will be on offer during the evening, with a complimentary glass of fizz on arrival, allowing you to get to know your fellow competitors in a fun and friendly atmosphere.

FRIDAY 13 JULY

Optional warm-up classes will run in the outdoor arenas throughout Friday, followed by a fun top score competition in the evening. Horse & Hound reporters will be on site for the duration of the festival, interviewing riders throughout, so we encourage you to say "hello" and share your stories.

SATURDAY 14 JULY

On Saturday the excitement builds as the championship classes get under way. Classes will run as single phase and results will count towards the final phase of the championship on Sunday. A fun pairs competition will also run on Saturday evening, followed by brilliant entertainment, with a barbecue and disco planned.

SUNDAY 15 JULY

On Sunday, riders will take part in the second phase of the championship competition to decide the overall Horse & Hound champions – results from both Saturday and Sunday will be combined to decide the overall placings for each championship height. Presentations and prize giving's will commence immediately after the results are announced, with a fantastic selection of prizes on offer for the top 10 at each level.

FRIDAY TOP SCORE HANDICAP CLASS

Open to horses and ponies

Starting heights: 75 - 85cm

Entry fee: £20

Each rider has 60 seconds to score as many points as possible, with each cleared obstacle worth between 10 – 100 points. The joker fence is worth 200 points, but if knocked down 200 points will be deducted from the score. Each fence may be jumped twice, from either direction. Once 60 seconds has passed a bell will be sounded to instruct the competitor to pass through the finish timer.

SATURDAY 75CM & 85CM SECTION PAIRS RELAY HANDICAP CLASSES

Open to horses and ponies, can be pairs of horses, ponies or mixed

Entry fee £30 per pair

The first rider will jump fences 1 to 6 before passing the baton to the second rider, who is required to jump fences 7 to 12. If a competitor is eliminated the other rider is required to take over and complete the course. Time penalties of four seconds are incurred for each knockdown. First disobediences during the round are not penalised, but the second disobedience incurs elimination.

ENTRIES

This is a friendly event where we encourage competitors to all get to know each other throughout the weekend and encourage one another to do well. Please help build this atmosphere by entering the correct class for your level. The organisers, Arena UK, reserve the right to refuse an entry they feel has entered an incorrect class due to the horse or rider's previous results

TOP SCORE HANDICAP CLASS: £20

PAIRS RELAY HANDICAP CLASSES: £30 per pair

FIRST AID: £5 per rider, per day

PRIZES

WARM-UP CLASSES: rosettes from 1st to 6th

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES: rosettes from 1st to 10th, with a fantastic selection of prizes on offer for the top 10 at each level

FACILITIES AND EXTRAS

STABLING – Temporary stables are available at £45 for one night, £65 for two, or £75 for the duration of the festival (earliest arrival Thursday afternoon, latest departure Sunday evening). Day stables are available at £30. Limited permanent stables are available on request. All stables are provided with a base bed only. Shavings (£10) and haylage (£9) are available to buy from Arena UK and can be pre-ordered on entry.

HOOK-UP – Available for lorries at £20 per night, with plenty of parking on hard standing. Onsite toilets and showers available

ARENAS – All classes will be run on excellent all-weather surfaces

CATERING – Bistro, restaurant and bar facilities available, overlooking the collecting ring

ABOUT THE VENUE

Arena UK offers unrivalled equestrian facilities, boasting Europe's largest outdoor all-weather surface arena, coupled with a magnificent indoor arena, warm-up area, covered collecting ring, ring-side restaurant, dedicated hospitality areas and a Pavilion with a large viewing gallery.

DIRECTIONS

Please use the A1 to access Arena UK. There is direct access from the Gonerby Moor, North Grantham interchange on the A1 (Grantham Services). Follow signs to Equestrian Centre, approximately half a mile from the A1.

Please note the alternative route through Sedgebrook and Allington off the A52 is not suitable for horseboxes due to narrow roads and a (12ft) height restriction bridge.

RULES & REGULATIONS

- All classes are to be judged in accordance with British Showjumping rules
- The Judges and Organisers decision is final
- Riding hard hats must be current to BS EN1384, PAS 015 or ASTM F1163 standards. Riding hats must be worn and correctly secured at all times when riders are mounted
- Prizes may be limited in accordance with British Showjumping Rule No. 76.6
- No attendee shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible for as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or prepare to compete, in any showjumping class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury at any time (British Showjumping Rule No. 82.20)
- The Show Organisers have the right to cancel any class with less than three entries
- Once a class has been entered, no refund will be given
- Dogs are to be kept on leads at all times
- In the event of any rider travelling to a show on their own, details of a contact should be left with the secretary in case of an accident
- Photographers and videographers will be in attendance throughout the competition and competitors should be aware that these images may be used in print and online by Arena UK and Horse & Hound as required
- The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone attending. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents
- Instructions given by any Official working at the showjumping event must be obeyed
- Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger may be asked to leave the showground immediately
- Owners enter their horses/ponies at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the show organisers
- Any person who fails to comply with these terms and conditions will be liable to forfeit their fees and expulsion from the showground
- It is the rider's responsibility to know the rules of the competition including any eligibility restrictions and ensure they are entering the correct class(es).
