

Mucking out onto car parks is strictly forbidden

Please ask organizers before riding on grass. Any lunging is by prior permission only, and is not permitted on any of the outdoor all-weather surfaces or in the indoor arenas

Horses/ponies must not be left unattended at any time when tied up to the outside of horseboxes or trailers. They must not be allowed to dig up the lorry park surface. No horses to be tied to buildings, stables or fencing at any time

Only designated muck heaps must be used when mucking out stables and/or horseboxes. No other rubbish/waste must be disposed of on the muck heap, this must be disposed of in the rubbish bins provided.

Smoking is only permitted in designated areas, and prohibited around the stable block All dogs must be kept on leads. Dogs are not permitted in any of the cafes or bar. All dog poop must be picked up and disposed of the bins provided

All horse and ponies must only move at walk through all public areas including those shared with pedestrian

Designated horse-walks must be used at all times to cross the site in walk only. Only ridden or led horses/ponies must enter the horse-walks

Pedestrians must use the pedestrian walkways at all times. Pedestrians crossing the horse-walk must do so at the designated signed crossing points, ensuring the horse-walk is clear of horses before crossing

No bicycles, scooters or segways may be used on the show ground at any time

No competitor / rider shall allow a stallion for which they are responsible as owner, lessee, authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure competitors, officials or other members of the public are not put at risk of injury

Arena UK Limited reserves the right to refuse entry to a class and/or the show ground

Photographers and videographers may attend competitions and events with prior permission, competitors should be aware that by entering an event authorises their consent to these images being used in print and online by Arena UK Limited and show/class sponsors as required Children must be under adult supervision at all times

All competitors/riders must wear correctly fastened hats to current approved safety standards and be correctly and appropriately dressed at all times when riding
