No obstacle may be set at a lower height than the obstacle preceding it.

The competition is judged under Table A not against the clock with a time limit of two minutes.


In the event of a disobedience, the competitor must restart the course at the obstacle where the error occurred, but may make his/her approach at an angle from outside the space between the obstacles and is not required or allowed to take any of the previous obstacles again. If an obstacle is disturbed as the result of a disobedience, the procedure in Rule 251.4 must be applied, but no time penalty is incurred. In the event of equality of faults for first place there will be up to four successive jumps-off not against the clock. The first jump-off must be over all six obstacles, but

the course may be reduced progressively for each further jump-off to a minimum of three obstacles by removing in succession first, second and third obstacles.

The Judge at his/her discretion may terminate the competition after the third jump-off. In the event of equality of faults in the final jump-off competitors are placed equal and divide the prize money.

Competitors who withdraw from or retire during a jump-off are placed equal with those who are eliminated in the same jump-off (Rules 203, 204).

- 2. So far as permitted by law the Organiser, its officers, employees and representatives will not be liable to any person whosoever whilst upon, entering, or leaving the Showground for any loss, damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items
- 3. Each Exhibitor must keep the Organiser its officers, employees and representatives fully indemnified against all losses, actions, costs, claims, demands and expenses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence by him or by any one attending the Show, in connection with his entry or otherwise expressly or impliedly with his authority. Therefore, all Exhibitors, Competitors and Owners are strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance. The Organiser cannot advise on policies or their suitability and it is the individual's responsibility to obtain advice wherever necessary. Exhibitors, Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regard to health and safety. The attention of exhibitors with stallions is drawn to BS Rule 82.21. No member of the BS/BD shall allow a stallion for which he is responsible, as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the Classes in accordance with BS rules.
- 5. An entry made by the person making the entries shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the Conditions herein contained.
- 6. JUMPING COMPETITIONS. This event is organised in accordance with the rules of the British Show Jumping Association.
- 7. SUBSTITUTIONS Are in accordance with BS Rules.
- 8. ORDER OF JUMPING. The order of jumping for classes in the Indoor Championship Arena day, will be drawn. Horses must jump in the order they appear on the Running Order, which will be posted, unless special permission has been obtained from the Judges.

- 15. 16) PRIZE MONEY. Prize money will be paid by cheque after the event, please ensure you leave your address with the entries office. In the event of insufficient starters rule 76.6.1 may be applied.
- 16. 17) The Organisers reserve the right to invite riders to compete in championship classes.
- 17. 18) ENTRIES. (a) CLOSING DATE: Entries close on 10th September 19 or before if maximums are reached. (b) The Show may at its absolute discretion, decline any entry, or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign any reason or being liable for any compensation. (c) Entry fees that are not received in full by 4th October may be subject to a 100% surcharge.
- 19) REFUND OF ENTRY FEES. Refunds will only be made in accordance with BS Rule 79.4.1. and not at all after 12 noon on 10th September. Stabling fees will not be refunded.
- 19. 20) MEDICAL CHARGE. Exhibitors are required to contribute £5 per rider per day towards medical cover.
- 20. 21) FARRIER & VETERINARY SURGEON. The services of a vet & farrier are available at the show. Owners and/or the person responsible are responsible for any costs incurred.
- 21. 22) MOTOR BIKES, SCOOTERS & BICYCLES Motorbikes & bicycles WILL NOT BE PERMITTED anywhere on the showground.
- 22. 24) TROPHIES. Trophies are all perpetual & the winner is responsible for their safe return and insurance 18 when in their possession. Trophies should be collected from the Show Office.
- 23. 25) Electric Hook Up A limited number of electric hook ups are available. The power source is via a generator. The event will endeavour to provide continuous supply but cannot guarantee this.
- 24. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

- 25. Access to the showground on Sunday 15th September will not be before 14:00. Competitors may not arrive between 2200 hrs and 0600 hrs without prior agreement with the show.
- 26. A 5mph speed limit will be strictly enforced within the showground.
- 27. Open fires will not be allowed under any circumstance. Purpose built Barbeques will be allowed under strict supervision.

- 41. No food or drink can be consumed in the cafes or bar areas which has not been bought from Arena UK
- 42. Only animals competing at an event may use the facilities without prior permission from an Arena UK official
- 43. Arena UK Limited operates a zero-tolerance policy on abuse and bad behaviour towards our staff, judges, officials and other members of the public. Anyone found guilty of this will be asked to leave the showground immediately and not return and they will forfeit any monies paid for food, drink, stabling or entries
- 44. To comply with Premises Licence regulations, only alcohol bought from Arena UK may be consumed in any of the indoor facilities, bars or cafes unless by prior written agreement. We reserve the right to confiscate any alcohol found that has not been bought from Arena UK
- 45. Photographers and videographers may attend competitions and events with prior permission, competitors should be aware that by entering an event authorises their consent to these images being used in print and online by Arena UK Limited and show/class sponsors as required Children must be under adult supervision at all times
- 46. All competitors/riders must wear correctly fastened hats to current approved safety standards and be correctly and appropriately dressed at all times when riding
- 47. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone attending. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any Official or member of Arena UK staff must be obeyed.
- 48. Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger may be asked to leave the showground immediately. Owners enter their horses/ponies at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the show organisers.
