Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification.

Those horses that have competed in the Senior Foxhunter Championship in 2019 are not eligible for qualification to the 2020 Championship.

If combined with an open: In the event of 30 or more starters the class will be split with two sets of prize money. Classes 3 & 4 will be run consecutively. There will be one course walk for both classes before class 3. Prize giving for both classes will be after class 4. Two sets of prizes will be awarded.

Entry qualifications: To be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships and Olympic Games are not eligible).

#### For both:

a) registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 375 Points,

b) registered horses born on or after 1st January 2013, irrespective of points. Horses will only be eligible for qualification if they reach the age of six years or under in the same calendar year as the Winter Novice Championship final. to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members. Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team (4\* or 5\* Nations Cup in the last 10 years, World, European Championships and Olympic Games are not eligible).

Qualifies for: The SEIB Winter Novice Championship at the Royal International Horse Show. No competitor may ride more than two horses in the Final. Horses that are disregarded under Rule 506.6 that otherwise would have qualified may be substituted in the Final for horses already qualified by the same rider, subject to Rule 79.4.

Numbers to qualify: Top two horses disregarding those already qualified and horses ridden by riders who have already qualified two horses for the Championship.

#### Rule 290.15 - Pre-Entry Drawn Order

Entries may possibly be accepted before 9.00am providing that the number of entries are less than 60 (with the exception of County shows). Once entries reach 60 before 9.00am the class will be closed. Any entries taken on the day must compete first in the drawn order.

Entry qualifications: to be ridden by Adult, Associate or Junior Members.

(a) For registered horses in Grade C that have not won a total of 700 points. Four double clears will qualify - in accordance with rule 310.6

(b) For all registered horses born on or after 1 January 2012, irrespective of points. Horses will be eligible for double clear qualification to attend second rounds providing they reach the age of seven years or under in the same calendar year as the Foxhunter Final - in accordance with rule 310.6 Four double clears will qualify.

Qualifies for: The Senior Foxhunter Second Round.

Qualifying period: 1st June-31st May inclusive. Numbers to qualify: Those horses that jump a clear round in the First Round, followed by a clear round in the jump-off, in at least four Senior Foxhunter First Round competitions in any qualifying period will qualify to compete in a Second Round, irrespective of their placings for prize money. Horses in the class must go into the jump off and go clear to gain its double clear round qualification. However, if they qualify again as a Grade B again, they will compete in the Grade B section of the final. There will be dual qualification of double clears for the National B&C Handicap Championship. - 1. The Organiser referred to in these Rules and Conditions shall hereinafter mean Winter Classic Arena UK Limited, Allington Lane, Allington, Grantham, NG32 2EF will hereinafter be referred to as The Show.
- 2. So far as permitted by law the Organiser, its officers, employees and representatives will not be liable to any person whosoever whilst upon, entering, or leaving the Showground for any loss, damage, death injury or accident to persons or property or for lost or stolen items
- 3. Each Exhibitor must keep the Organiser its officers, employees and representatives fully indemnified against all losses, actions, costs, claims, demands and expenses arising directly or indirectly out of any act, omission or negligence by him or by any one attending the Show, in connection with his entry or otherwise expressly or impliedly with his authority. Therefore, all Exhibitors, Competitors and Owners are strongly advised to take out third-party liability insurance. The Organiser cannot advise on policies or their suitability and it is the individual's responsibility to obtain advice wherever necessary. Exhibitors, Owners and Competitors are personally responsible for ensuring that they take all necessary measures with regard to health and safety. The attention of exhibitors with stallions is drawn to BS Rule 82.21. No member of the BS/BD shall allow a stallion for which he is responsible, as owner, lessee, authorised agent, or rider to attend a show, compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other horses/ponies, competitors and members of the public are not put at risk of injury.
- 4. The Organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the Classes in accordance with BS rules.
- 5. An entry made by the person making the entries shall be deemed to be an acceptance of the Conditions herein contained.
- 6. JUMPING COMPETITIONS. This event is organised in accordance with the rules of the British Show Jumping Association.
- 7. SUBSTITUTIONS Are in accordance with BS Rules.
- 8. ORDER OF JUMPING. The order of jumping for classes in the Indoor Championship Arena day, will be drawn. Horses must jump in the order they appear on the Running Order, which will be posted, unless special permission has been obtained from the Judges.
- 9. STANDARD. When a standard set by the Judges has been reached, any competitor making more than the fixed number of penalties shall be retired.
- 10. OBJECTIONS. Objections should be made in writing in accordance with BS Rule 198. A £100 deposit in cash will be required per objection.
- 11. VACCINATION AGAINST EQUINE INFLUENZA All horses at the Show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza.
- 12. There will be random checking of certificates and any horse or pony found without a valid certificate will not be permitted to remain on the showground.

- 15. 16) PRIZE MONEY. Prize money will be paid by cheque after the event, please ensure you leave your address with the entries office. In the event of insufficient starters rule 76.6.1 may be applied.
- 16. 17) The Organisers reserve the right to invite riders to compete in championship classes.
- 17. 18) ENTRIES. (a) CLOSING DATE: Entries close on 10<sup>th</sup> September 19 or before if maximums are reached. (b) The Show may at its absolute discretion, decline any entry, or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign any reason or being liable for any compensation. (c) Entry fees that are not received in full by 4<sup>th</sup> October may be subject to a 100% surcharge.
- 18. 19) REFUND OF ENTRY FEES. Refunds will only be made in accordance with BS Rule 79.4.1. and not at all after 12 noon on 10<sup>th</sup> September. Stabling fees will not be refunded.
- 19. 20) MEDICAL CHARGE. Exhibitors are required to contribute £5 per rider per day towards medical cover.
- 20. 21) FARRIER & VETERINARY SURGEON. The services of a vet & farrier are available at the show. Owners and/or the person responsible are responsible for any costs incurred.
- 21. 22) MOTOR BIKES, SCOOTERS & BICYCLES Motorbikes & bicycles WILL NOT BE PERMITTED anywhere on the showground.
- 22. 24) TROPHIES. Trophies are all perpetual & the winner is responsible for their safe return and insurance 18 when in their possession. Trophies should be collected from the Show Office.
- 23. 25) Electric Hook Up A limited number of electric hook ups are available. The power source is via a generator. The event will endeavour to provide continuous supply but cannot guarantee this.
- 24. IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

- 25. Access to the showground on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> September will not be before 14:00. Competitors may not arrive between 2200 hrs and 0600 hrs without prior agreement with the show.
- 26. A 5mph speed limit will be strictly enforced within the showground.
- 27. Open fires will not be allowed under any circumstance. Purpose built Barbeques will be allowed under strict supervision.
- 28. Horses must not be left tethered or unattended whilst out of the stable or transporters under any circumstances.
- 29. Dogs off leads are strictly forbidden on the show ground.
- 30. The main fire point is located at the stable manager's office.
- 31. All horses must remain within the designated areas and walkways at all times. It is strictly forbidden to exercise or move horses in any areas other than those designated as walkways, warm up areas or stabling area.
- 32. The stabling area is designated as a no smoking area.

- 39. The show director will liaise with the Fire Brigade on their arrival.

- 41. No food or drink can be consumed in the cafes or bar areas which has not been bought from Arena UK
- 42. Only animals competing at an event may use the facilities without prior permission from an Arena UK official

Anyone found guilty of this will be asked to leave the showground immediately and not return and they will forfeit any monies paid for food, drink, stabling or entries
- 44. To comply with Premises Licence regulations, only alcohol bought from Arena UK may be consumed in any of the indoor facilities, bars or cafes unless by prior written agreement. We reserve the right to confiscate any alcohol found that has not been bought from Arena UK
- 45. Photographers and videographers may attend competitions and events with prior permission, competitors should be aware that by entering an event authorises their consent to these images being used in print and online by Arena UK Limited and show/class sponsors as required Children must be under adult supervision at all times
- 46. All competitors/riders must wear correctly fastened hats to current approved safety standards and be correctly and appropriately dressed at all times when riding
- 47. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health and Safety of everyone attending. For these measures to be effective everyone present must themselves take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. Instructions given by any Official or member of Arena UK staff must be obeyed.
- 48. Any animal not under control or in any way constituting a danger may be asked to leave the showground immediately. Owners enter their horses/ponies at their own risk and it is a condition of entry that no liability of any kind attaches itself to the show organisers.
